

This assignment will require you to produce a secondary-source bibliography based on the author and/or work you have been individually assigned. The bibliography should include the following scholarly genres:

1. **Six journal articles** (make sure that all of these articles are held in the Sterne Library collection) about your author/work. At least one of the articles must have been published in each of the last four decades: the 1970s, 80s, 90s, and 2000s. Please attach photocopies (or computer printouts) of the first page of each of these articles.
2. **Two articles from edited collections** that have substantial commentary about your author/work.
3. **Three books (monographs) of literary criticism** that have some substantial commentary specifically about your assigned author/work.
4. A **biography** of your subject author.
5. **Two reviews** of any one of the critical books in #3 above, and **two reviews of the biography** you list in #4. Please attach photocopies (or computer printouts) of any two of these reviews.
6. **Three publicly accessible websites** with significant scholarly content about your author/work.

This should make a total of 19 items in the bibliography, all of which (excepting the websites) should be available in the Sterne Library collection or through Sterne's databases. These items should be presented in the standard MLA bibliography format, alphabetized and double-spaced as one would with any "Works Cited" or "Bibliography" page. In addition, your bibliography should be accompanied by 6 photocopies of the journal article front pages and 2 photocopies of any two of the reviews.

Here is a checklist you can use to make sure you've listed all the required materials:

- ___ 6 journal articles (with photocopies)
- ___ 2 articles/chapters from edited collections
- ___ 3 books of literary criticism
- ___ 1 biography
- ___ 4 reviews (with 2 photocopies)
- ___ 3 websites

In addition to these hardcopy materials, please send along an electronic copy of the bibliography itself—a simple email attachment will be fine. Your bibliography will not be fully submitted until I receive this electronic version.
